**Duplicate Programming for Wildland:** Zones 1 and 3 have been programmed with the channels necessary to operate on a Wildland Fire in our district, including incoming mutual aid partners. The two zones match to allow the use of the A/B/C switch on the radio. Zone 30 is also still programmed for initial Attack use, and is a great option for more in-depth needs of a rapidly expanding incident, if needed.

For communications in Waterton Canyon... Crews set mobile radios in vehicles to CO\_SMPX1 (Zone 1 or 3- Channel 11). Officer talks to District Chief on this channel. District Chief parks part-way down Waterton Canyon monitoring CO\_SMPX1 to relay messages out on CO\_REDSW (Zone 1 or 3-Channel 9).
